Since 2002, dynamic Prague-based, globally-inspired musical ambassadors Jull Dajen have entertained audiences and energized dancers at festivals and clubs across Europe. Jull Dajen draw deeply on Celtic, Scandinavian and Brittany Coast folk music while taking those rich traditions to new places with their distinctive blend of flute, violin, accordion and guitar over a lively groove. In addition to traditional music, the influences of modern-day cross-pollinators like Manu Chao, JPP, Fairport Convention and Jethro Tull echo through Jull Dajen's acclaimed studio and live albums and acclaimed concert tours.
